

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

To graduate from a University Prep Schools high school, each student must:

1. Complete at least eight (8) semesters of high school. To be issued a diploma, the academic transcript must show successful completion of the following:

- 3. Receive academic credit (as measured by mastery of specific content expectations for each course) for programs of instruction as specified below. Courses in which students receive a failing (F) or incomplete (I) grade do not count toward graduation credit although they are counted against the overall cumulative grade point average.

^{***}The first year of foreign language will be considered if earned in grade 8. Proficiency testing required.
