As a charter school, we follow a structured process for enrolling students into our schools. Our policy for enrollment has remained consistent since 2013 that new students are assigned to our school by the U Prep Schools Enrollment Coordinator. The process allows for siblings of currently enrolled students and children of district employees to receive priority in the enrollment process, but only if those students apply during our open enrollment period. Otherwise all students are admitted on a first-come, first-served basis. Currently our curriculum focus is to promote rigor and relevance for our students. Our curriculum guide is available in the main office for all content subjects. In grades 6 – 8 we have adopted Engage New York for English and Math. Our curriculum is available upon request in the school's main office. Each year we are making adaptations to our school improvement plan based upon the academic needs of our students. UPSM Middle School is in its third year of a five-year cycle for continuous improvement. Currently there are 435 students enrolled at UPSM Middle School, and 97% of parents attend parent-teacher conferences each year.
