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## Technology Enhancements: Blocksi Education Everywhere at U Prep

Our scholars are online more than ever due to virtual learning. To ensure their safety in the digital space, we have exciting technology enhancements currently in place at U Prep. We are excited to announce the addition of the Blocksi Manager Education Everywhere system to our digital tools. This software program allows parents, school administrators, and teachers to monitor their students' activities, which helps prevent cyberbullying, cyberstalking, and online predators.

Blocksi Manager Education Everywhere also provides an Al-powered tool, called Student Safety, that allows school administrators, principals, and parents to detect harmful behavior on any student's Gmail, Google Docs, Google Drive, or YouTube accounts.

This technology is currently active for the entire U Prep Network. Teachers and parents can immediately access the Student Safety or Content filtering functions for student accounts. This program helps us provide security, protection, and support to our scholars while they operate on virtual platforms.


### **Celebrating Black History Month**
