Important!!! Notification of possible exposure to Covid-19 MUST be sent to those identified as CLOSE CONTACTS ONLY within 48 hours of the potential exposure.

## Important Notes

- The definition of a close contact according to CDC guidelines is someone who was within 6 feet of a person diagnosed with COVID-19 for a total of 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period. The definition of a close contact applies regardless of whether either person was wearing a mask. Please make sure those you report as close contacts fit within these guidelines.
- Quarantine should be used for students, teachers, and staff who might have been exposed to COVID-19. Close contacts, identified through contact tracing, should quarantine unless they are fully vaccinated, or have tested positive in the last 3 months, and do not have any symptoms. Students, teachers, and staff who are in quarantine should stay home and follow the direction of the local public health department about when it is safe for them to be around others.
